### Receiving Eucharist

As Catholics we believe that at the Eucharist we receive the Body and Blood of Christ. Here are some helpful postures to help with the sacredness of the moment.

As you come forward to receive communion, as a sign of reverence for the Eucharist, please bow to the Eucharist as the person in front of you receives Communion. When receiving Holy Communion hold your hands out and upwards, forming a throne to receive the King of Kings. When receiving the Blood of Christ, take the chalice when it is given to you by the communion minister, take a small sip, and then hand the chalice back to the communion minister. When the communion minister says "The Body of Christ" or "The Blood of Christ", answer with a strong "Amen" which means "Yes, I believe".

Consume the host immediately after receiving it.

For those receiving a blessing at Communion, come forward with your arms crossed across your chest. We offer the following prayer. *My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen*

After returning to your seat, please remain standing and join in with the Communion hymn. We take time for silent prayer, seated or kneeling, after the last person has received the Eucharist. Please stay in the Church until the whole celebration is complete. You don't want to miss anything! Join us in singing the closing hymn ... and carry the Peace of Christ with you to your homes.
