

RCIA CORNER

Lent ... 40 Days for What?

This was our final week in the Catechumenate period of RCIA. Like many of you we began our Lenten Journey with Mass on Ash Wednesday. After Mass we returned to Room 2 to hear about Lent - why and how it is celebrated.

If the 2019 Lenten period begins on March 6 and concludes on April 20, a total of 46 calendar days, why do we say that Lent is 40 days long?

Why is Lent 40 days long?

1. Moses stayed on the mountain for 40 days with the Lord (Exodus 24:18)
2. Elijah traveled 40 days to Horeb to encounter the Lord (Kings 19:8)
3. Jesus spent 40 days in the wilderness praying and fasting (Matthew 4:2)

March 10, 2019 Reflection - 1st Sunday in Lent

Deuteronomy 26:4-10 • Romans 10:8-13 • Luke 4:1-13

"Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus...was led ...into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil..."

Luke 4:1-2

As we begin to journey through Lent, we remember that Jesus was called to fast for 40 days before he started his ministry. In this time, Luke tells us that he was tempted by the devil. Will we also be tempted during Lent? Most likely. We will be tempted to stop fasting because it's "too hard." We may be tempted to eat meat on Friday, because "everyone else does." Countless other temptations may arise. In those moments, let us ask the Holy Spirit to fill us with God's grace, that we may overcome the temptation and enter into the spirit of sacrifice to understand how great Jesus' love for us was by following his example.

Dear Lord, thank you for the fast you made in the desert. Thank you for your example in showing us that we should not give in to temptations, but have faith in the Father and show him our love by the sacrifices we make.

What kind of fast am I going to make for Lent? What are some ways I can avoid temptations?


