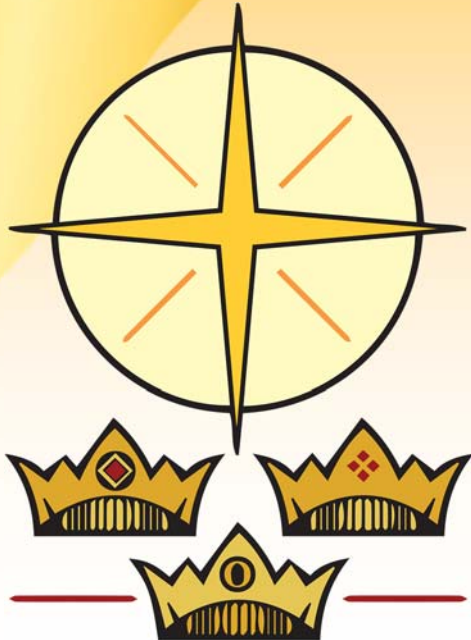

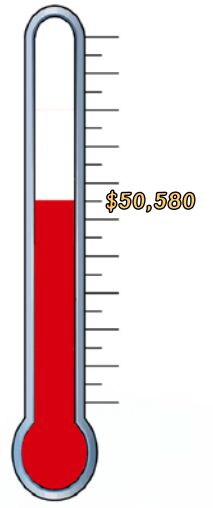


Did you know that you can send your weekly tithes and offerings now by e-transfer?

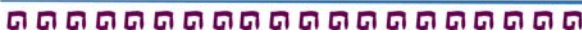
Children's Liturgy
