RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or Children) is a process of discernment. We provide

Through our weeks together you will receive presentations and information intended to help grow your relationship with God and support your decision if joining the Catholic Church is for you.

While RCIA is correctly, a series of rites which mark the preparation of the Candidate on their journey to join the Catholic Church, with the final rite being the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil, colloquially, we use RCIA to describe the journey for learning, discussion and discernment of an individual's decision to join the Catholic Church. Through RCIA the pieces of our faith begin to make sense as we navigate the puzzle of life.


