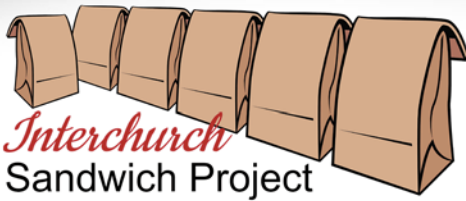

### SACRAMENT PREPARATION

#### Baptism Registration is ongoing

Preparation classes are required, so register as soon as possible. Registration can be submitted and classes taken prior to the birth of your child.

#### First Reconciliation

We are accepting registrations for children entering Grade 4 or higher in the **September 2023** school year.

**Anointing of Sick** – available to anyone who is seriously ill or preparing for surgery

### Are you looking for something new on your life's journey?

Whether you are discerning a decision to join the Catholic church or supporting someone who is, RCIA has a place for everyone.

- ✓ Have you longed to share in communion with the Resurrection Parish Community by receiving the Eucharist at Mass?
- ✓ Are you looking for a way to personally share your faith?
- ✓ Are you wondering what Catholics believe, why we do the things we do or perhaps looking for a refresher on your Catholic faith?
- ✓ Are you wondering if the Catholic Church is for you?



**RCIA** (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or Children) is a process of discernment. We provide a no pressure, no judgement environment for you to explore Christianity and the Catholic Church supported by a member of our Parish Community. Through our weeks together you will receive presentations and information intended to help grow your relationship with God and support your decision if joining the Catholic Church is for you.

While RCIA is correctly, a series of rites which mark the preparation of the Candidate on their journey to join the Catholic Church, with the final rite being the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil, colloquially, we use RCIA to describe the journey for learning, discussion and discernment of an individual's decision to join the Catholic Church. Through RCIA the pieces of our faith begin to make sense as we navigate the puzzle of life.

## **A Prayer for Oscar Romero and Other Departed Priests**

It helps, now and then, to step back and take a long view.

The kingdom is not only beyond our efforts, it is even beyond our vision.

We accomplish in our lifetime only a tiny fraction of the magnificent enterprise that is God's work.

Nothing we do is complete, which is a way of saying that the kingdom always lies beyond us.

No statement says all that could be said.

No prayer fully expresses our faith.

No confession brings perfection.

No pastoral visit brings wholeness.

No program accomplishes the church's mission.

No set of goals and objectives includes everything.

It may be incomplete,

but it is a beginning, a step along the way,

an opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and do the rest.

We may never see the end results, but that is the difference between the master builder and the worker.

We are workers, not master builders; ministers not messiahs.

We are prophets of a future not our own.

This is what we are about.

We plant the seeds that one day will grow.

We water seeds already planted, knowing that they hold future promise.

We lay foundations that will need further development.

We provide yeast that produces far beyond our capabilities.

We cannot do everything, and there is a sense of liberation in realizing that. This enables us to do something, and to do it very well.

Amen.

ÓSCAR ROMERO (1917-1980) was archbishop of San Salvador. A zealous advocate for the poor of his country and a tireless voice for reconciliation amid civil war, Romero was assassinated while saying Mass. Though widely attributed to Romero, the prayer was actually offered by Cardinal John Dearden of Detroit in a homily in 1979. Dearden was a kindred spirit to Romero: both preached peace and justice as central to the gospel.



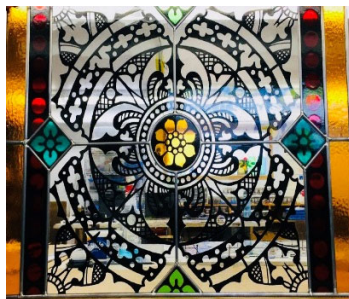

Did you know... The Key First Nation is a Nahkawé (Saulteaux) band located 15 kms south of Norquay with a population of approximately 1500 members who reside on and off reserve. Chief Ow-tah-pee-ka-kaw (He who Unlocks or The Key) signed an adhesion to Treaty four on September 24, 1875. In 1954, Gwen O'Soup was elected chief, the first Indigenous woman in Canada to hold this position. Due to federal and provincial government policies on child welfare, many children were taken away from their families and placed in non-Indigenous foster homes where these children experienced physical and sexual abuse and other abuses.
