

Workers can take the SGI Safe Ride transportation to Craven or have access to free parking if they take their own vehicle.

All workers will get a wristband entitling them to free access to the grounds and access to the concerts when not working.

## Baptism Registration is ongoing

Preparation classes are required, so register as soon as possible. Registration can be submitted and classes taken prior to the birth of your child.

#### First Reconciliation

We are accepting registrations for children entering Grade 4 or higher in the **September 2023** school year.

#### RCIA



#### Are you looking for something new on your life's journey?

Whether you are discerning a decision to join the Catholic church or supporting someone who is, RCIA has a place for everyone.

- Have you longed to share in communion with the Resurrection Parish Community by receiving the Eucharist at Mass?
- Are you looking for a way to personally share your faith?
- Are you wondering what Catholics believe, why we do the things we do or perhaps looking for a refresher on on your Catholic faith?
- ✓ Are you wondering if the Catholic Church is for you?



**RCIA** (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or Children) is a process of discernment. We provide a no pressure, no judgement environment for you to explore Christianity and the Catholic Church supported by a member of our Parish Community. Through our weeks together you will receive presentations and information intended to help grow your relationship with God and support your decision if joining the Catholic Church is for you.

While RCIA is correctly, a series of rites which mark the preparation of the Candidate on their journey to join the Catholic Church, with the final rite being the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil, colloquially, we use RCIA to describe the journey for learning, discussion and discernment of an individual's decision to join the Catholic Church. Through RCIA the pieces of our faith begin to make sense as we navigate the puzzle of life.

#### God is patiently waiting for you. Maybe now is your time to say yes! Everyone is welcome!

At RCIA there is a place for everyone! Seeker or Volunteer – all are welcome!


