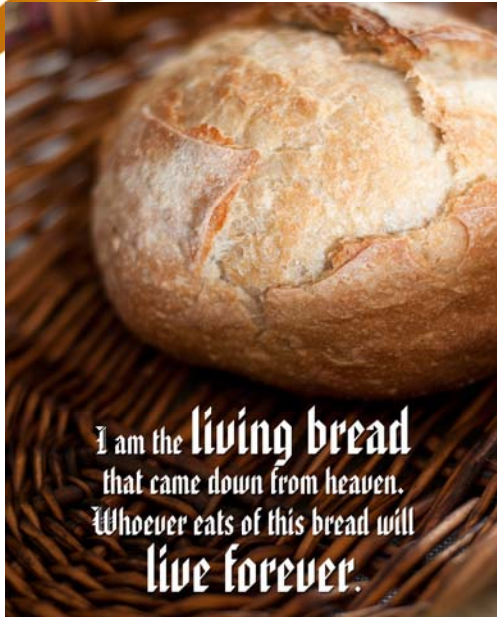

SACRAMENT PREPARATION

Baptism Registration is ongoing

Preparation classes are required, so register as soon as possible. Registration can be submitted and classes taken prior to the birth of your child.

First Reconciliation

We are accepting registrations for children entering Grade 4 or higher in the **September 2023** school year.

Whether you are discerning a decision to join the Catholic church or supporting someone who is, RCIA has a place for everyone.

- ✓ Have you longed to share in communion with the Resurrection Parish Community by receiving the Eucharist at Mass?
- ✓ Are you looking for a way to personally share your faith?
- ✓ Are you wondering what Catholics believe, why we do the things we do or perhaps looking for a refresher on your Catholic faith?
- ✓ Are you wondering if the Catholic Church is for you?



RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or Children) is a process of discernment. We provide a no pressure, no judgement environment for you to explore Christianity and the Catholic Church supported by a member of our Parish Community. Through our weeks together you will receive presentations and information intended to help grow your relationship with God and support your decision if joining the Catholic Church is for you.

While RCIA is correctly, a series of rites which mark the preparation of the Candidate on their journey to join the Catholic Church, with the final rite being the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil, colloquially, we use RCIA to describe the journey for learning, discussion and discernment of an individual's decision to join the Catholic Church. Through RCIA the pieces of our faith begin to make sense as we navigate the puzzle of life.

What is National Indigenous Peoples Day (NIPD)?

June 21 is National Indigenous Peoples Day. This is a day for all Canadians to recognize and celebrate the unique heritage, diverse cultures and outstanding contributions of First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples. The Canadian Constitution recognizes these three groups as Aboriginal peoples, also known as Indigenous peoples. Although these groups share many similarities, they each have their own distinct heritage, language, cultural practices and spiritual beliefs. In cooperation with Indigenous organizations, the Government of Canada chose June 21, the summer solstice, for National Aboriginal Day, now known as National Indigenous Peoples Day. For generations, many Indigenous peoples and communities have celebrated their culture and heritage on or near this day due to the significance of the summer solstice as the longest day of the year. Please check with your local community to see if there events you can join on June 21st.

Did you know... Piapot First Nation is a Cree Nation located south of Regina and has a population of approximately 2500 members who live on and off reserve. Chief Payepot (Payipwat meaning A Hole in the Sioux) signed Treaty 4 on September 9, 1875. He and other Cree chiefs refused to sign other treaties with the Canadian government and established themselves in Cypress Mountain, however, the government began to fear that these bands would join and would be impossible to control. Indian Commissioner, Edgar Dewdney, put in a policy of famine to force the bands to leave this area. Chief Piapot became a person of [piapotnation.com/history-2/](https://www.piapotnation.com/history-2/) for his continued efforts to fight for the rights of his people.
