

Prayers Answered - Alleluia

The COVID Pandemic has interrupted many things in our lives and in some cases caused great sorrow with the death or sickness of loved ones. These are serious matters and serious times.

In the life of the Catholic Church, the pandemic has interrupted our celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. These Sacraments are important and are typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil.

This year, due to the pandemic, we were unable to celebrate at the Vigil and since that time we have been praying for the Candidates, that there would soon be a time to celebrate.

With the opening up of Mass celebrations to include up to 30 people, Father Rick has asked us to prepare to celebrate. Celebrating within the limits and under the COVID restrictions means our celebration will look very different, but the importance of the sacraments will not change. At these celebrations the 20 Candidates who have been journeying toward this moment since last fall will be confirmed as members of the church. Some will be baptised and all will received the Eucharist. Additionally two young family members will also be baptised.




