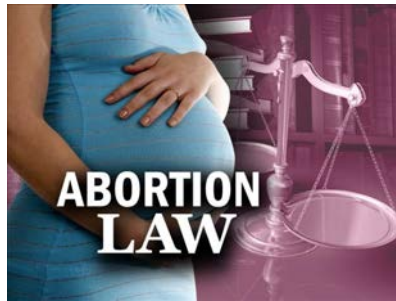
DID YOU KNOW?
