

Baptism

Registration for children under the age of seven is ongoing. Preparation classes are required. The following are the upcoming Baptism dates: Class September 20 with Baptisms on September 28, Class November 1 with Baptisms on November 9, Class January 31 with Baptisms on February 8, Class on May 23 with Baptisms on May 31.

Confirmation and First Eucharist classes (Grades 2+)

Preparation classes for the sacraments of Confirmation and First Eucharist will begin in January, 2026, for children in Grade 2 and up. There will be a Parent Meeting held on Thursday, December 4 at 6:30 pm in the Parish Hall. We ask that you register your child prior to the date of this meeting.

First Reconciliation (Grade 4+)

First Reconciliation classes for children in Grades 4 and older will begin on October 18, 2025. Pre-registration is required. The next intake will be in fall of 2025. Please contact sacraments@resurrectionparish.ca or call the parish office for more information.

Even though the apostles had lived with Jesus for three years, been witnesses of His miracles, and saw Him risen from the dead, it was not until they received the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Day of Pentecost that they were filled with courage to proclaim the Gospel to those around them.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is the reception of that same Spirit, completing our initiation sending us out into the community to tell others of the Risen Lord.

The Archdiocese of Regina is seeking a compassionate and dedicated **Hospital Chaplain/Spiritual Care Provider** to minister to Roman Catholic patients, families, and hospital staff. This individual will offer spiritual support and sacramental care to those experiencing illness and crisis within urgent care facilities in Regina, primarily at Pasqua Hospital. The position is grounded in the healing mission of the Church and involves collaboration with priests, volunteers, hospital staff, and families. Ideally this is a full-time role with on-call time required. Three-quarter time or half time will be considered.

Specific Duties

- Visit and minister to Roman Catholic patients, offering spiritual companionship and prayer.
- Coordinate the provision of sacraments with local clergy.
- Provide support to staff and family members in need of pastoral care.
- Attend family meetings when requested by the family, physician, or social worker.
- Assist priests with hospital ministry and maintain an up-to-date on-call clergy list.
- Facilitate, support, and train volunteer pastoral care workers.
- Plan and assist with liturgical services and celebrations, as needed.
- Develop relationships with clergy for ongoing collaboration in spiritual care.

Qualifications

- Completion of at least one unit of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE).
- Experience in spiritual care ministry within healthcare or similar settings.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Proven ability to work independently and collaboratively within interdisciplinary teams.
- Experience in organizing and training volunteers.
- Deep personal commitment to Jesus Christ and the ability to witness that faith in word and action.
- Willingness to participate in ongoing professional development in the field of pastoral care.
