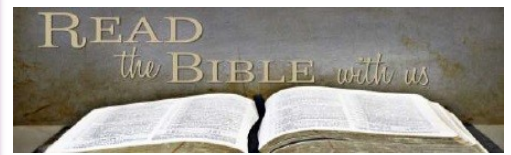

Purification and Enlightenment Period

During the period of Lent, the RCIA process is in its final period of preparation called Purification and Enlightenment. This is a period of internal reflection, as the Elect and Candidates prepare for the celebration of the Easter Mysteries. Like you we are seeking to purify our minds and hearts, as we search our conscience and seek/engage in reconciliation.

This week-end marks the half way point in the period, with only three weeks until Easter Sunday!

On March 23 we celebrated the 1st Scrutiny, on March 27 we were presented with the Apostle's Creed. On March 31 we will celebrate the 2nd Scrutiny and on April 7th the 3rd. On April 10th we will be presented with the Lord's Prayer.

As we share this Lenten journey together, we look anxiously toward Vigil where we will share with Eucharist and finally be in full communion with the Resurrection Community.



March 31, 2019 Reflection 4th Sunday in Lent

Joshua 5:9a, 10-12 • 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 • Luke 15:1-3,11-32

So he set off and went to his father. But while he was still far off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion; he ran and put his arms around him and kissed him... "This son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found!"

Luke 15:20, 24

The Gospel story today is about the Prodigal Son who wasted all of the money his father gave him and almost starved because he didn't have enough left to buy food for himself. It seems like the father would have been mad at him when he came home, but instead the father surprised everyone, even the son, by running out to meet him and welcoming him back by throwing a big party. Jesus wants us to know that God is like that with us. When we do something wrong and admit it, God doesn't punish us or make us feel worse, he rejoices that we want to start all over and try again. He says it's like we were dead but we have come back to life.

Dear Lord, help me to come back to you when I have done wrong. Help me to believe that you forgive me. What are some things we have done that we regret and need to ask forgiveness for? Who is good at welcoming us and still loving us, even when we make mistakes?
