We are accepting registrations for children entering Grade 4 or higher in the **September 2023** school year.

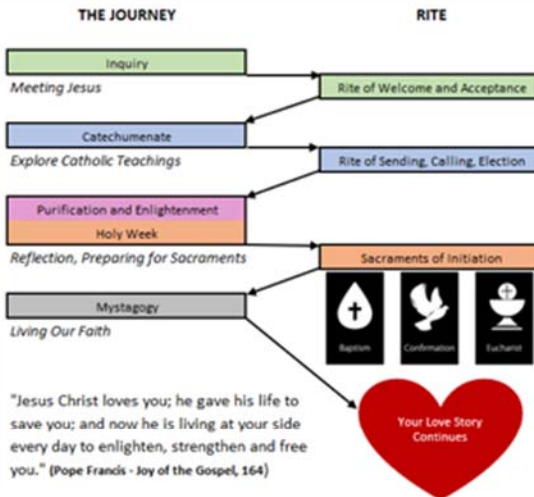

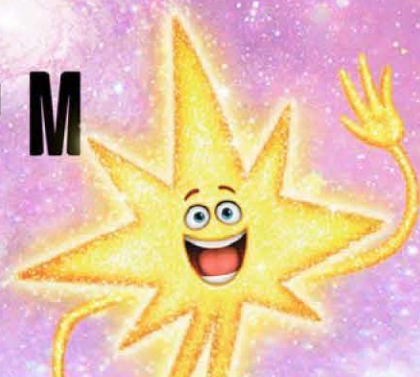

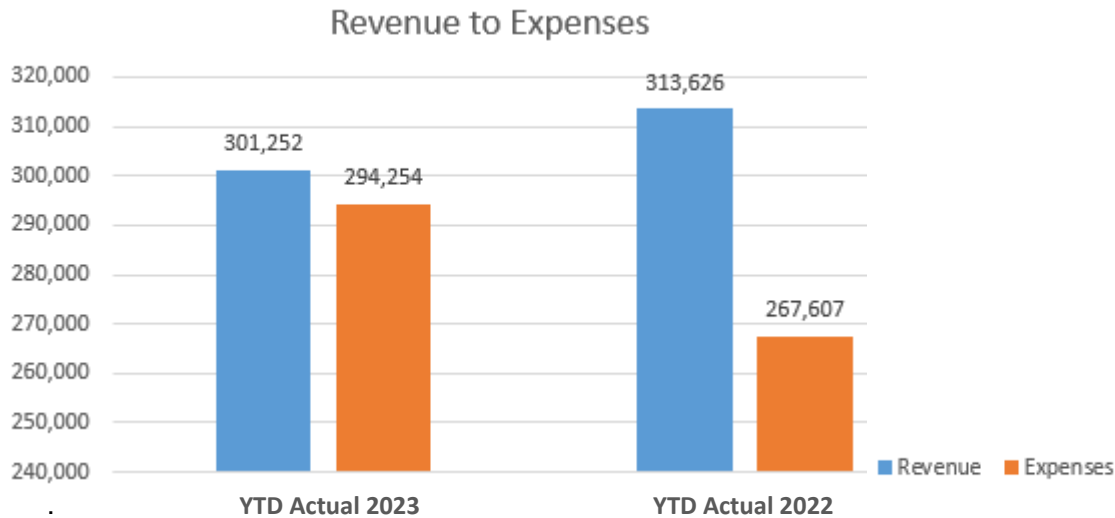

# Resurrection Parish April 30th, 2023 FINANCIAL REPORT

## 1. April Year to Date Financial Results - Operations



## 2. Highlights of Financials

- As shown above our April 30th, 2023 surplus is \$6998 our April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 surplus was \$46,019.
- Revenues are lower than last year due to less donations, and expenses are higher than last year due to increased costs for utilities as well as more expenditures for ministry and faith based programs happening within our Parish.
- In April our average daily revenue was \$2905 and our average daily expenses was \$2935. Your donations fund all the daily operations of the Parish.
- Remaining Debt as of April 30<sup>th</sup> is \$516,168.

## 3. Did you know?

- ❖ *We held a Welcome supper for new parishioners supported by the Parish with over 240 people in attendance, it was a great success!*
- ❖ *Our Parish participates in an Inner city Sandwich program. We provided 220 bagged lunches, on two Saturdays this year and plan to do at least three more times this year.*
- ❖ *Since January we have celebrated a total of 37 baptisms (including RCIA and RCIC) in our Parish. Congratulations to all the families!*

## 4. Parishioner update

- *We are preparing over 130 children for the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Eucharist that will be celebrated at the beginning of June this year. So exciting for our parish!*

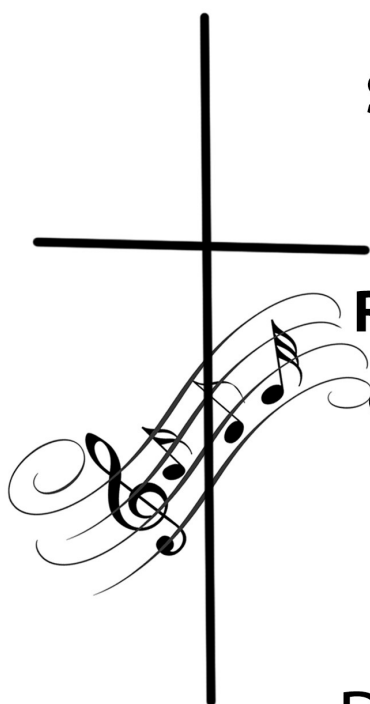

## A Word About Trauma...

Trauma and associated words are being used more now than ever. Do we know the origins of these words? Are their meanings different now than when they were first used? Each week we will explore a trauma-associated word's origins, meanings and evolution.

### Complex Trauma

The term complex trauma describes both children's exposure to multiple types of pervasive and chronic traumatic events that involve violence, betrayal, exploitation, and loss, such as maltreatment and living in an unsafe family, community, or school settings, as well as the wide-ranging, long-term impact of this exposure. Complex trauma can disrupt the child's secure bonding with caregiver(s), as well as the development and formation of crucial competencies, positive relationships, and a clear sense of self.

**itwewin Corner** (itwewin is the Cree word which means 'the word' or 'as it is said...')

Fr. John Weckend, Archdiocese of Regina Truth and Reconciliation Healing Committee.

Did you know... Pasqua First Nation is a Cree, Saulteaux, and Nakota/Dakota band located northeast of Regina and west of Fort Qu'Appelle with a population of approximately 2,000 members on and off reserve (69% live off the reserve). Chief Joseph Paskwa signed Treaty 4 on September 15, 1874.
