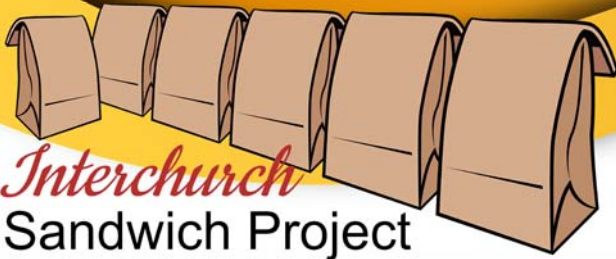

Kevin's art reflects a current style with traditional floral motifs reminiscent of beadwork, a homage to his late Kookum, who created beautiful works on moss bags, moccasins, and saddles. -

1. April Year to Date Financial Results - Operations:

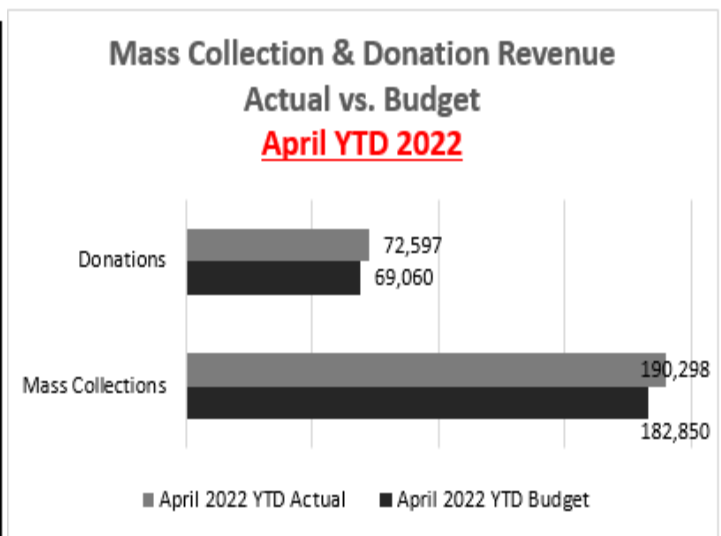
- April year-to-date financial results reflect a surplus of \$46, 018
- **A closer look at Mass Collections and Donations:**

Revenues:

The year to date Mass collections are \$7,448 higher than budgeted and overall donations are \$3,537 higher than budgeted, for which we are grateful. We had approved a very conservative budget due to all the unknowns surrounding the pandemic.

Expenses: Our expenses are 14.5% less than budgeted year to date, however some of the expenses that were budgeted for earlier in year will most likely happen in the next few months, also at this time we have two vacant positions in the parish.

2. Remaining debt as of April 30th, 2022 is: **\$636,059.**

3. One of our finance council goals at this time is to focus on debt repayment. Because of your amazing ongoing support of our Parish, on April 12th, 2022 our Parish was able to make a large debt repayment of \$196,895 towards our long term debt of the Phase II of the building.

Introduction of New Members

David Kopriva – Member at Large

Years ago, I had the opportunity to talk to students who were interested in becoming healthcare professionals, and one of them asked me why I chose to be a doctor.

“Sometimes I am able to save a life,” I answered, “sometimes I relieve suffering, but what draws me to this work is the privilege of accompanying a person on what is often the worst day of their life.”

My daughter, high-school-aged at the time, was somewhere in the back of the room. She will be graduating from medical school later this spring and taking her

place as my colleague. I owe it to her to weigh in on some of the most important and difficult moral and ethical issues that affect our profession.



As Catholics involved in healthcare, we are drawn by the principles that our jobs uphold: a reverence for life and concern for the good of the person. But increasingly, the values of the Culture of Life are being subjugated to newer North American cultural values that permit an individual to choose their own death or even the death of someone else. The rights of choice are increasingly imposed as duties of service upon a medical profession that has traditionally rejected death as a therapeutic option. If I do not help to work through these issues, then they will be forced on my daughter and her generation of physicians. There are answers but they will require creative solutions and a carefully crafted strategy. The Church is up to this task.

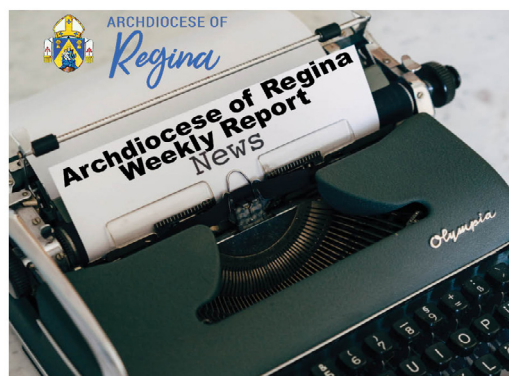
