A Word About Trauma...

Trauma and associated words are being used more now than ever. Do we know the origins of these words? Are their meanings different now than when they were first used? Each week we will explore a trauma-associated word's origins, meanings and evolution.

Dissociate (dɪˈsəʊʃɪ, ɛɪt, -sɪ-) dis-so-ci-ate is a noun. In the mid-16th century, it is from the Latin *n* dissociat- 'separated,' from the verb dissociate, from *dis-* (expressing reversal) + *sociare* 'join together' (from *socius* 'companion'). Attested from the 1540s as a past-participle adjective meaning "separated." Dissociated in psychology (1890) was "characterized by mental disjunction," hence dissociated personality (1905) is a "pathological state in which two or more distinct personalities exist in the same person." Dissociation is one way the mind copes with too much stress, such as during a traumatic event.

Did you know... Ochapowace First Nation is a Plains Cree band located on the North side of Round Lake and the Qu'Appelle River and has a population of approximately 1500 band members who live on and off reserve. Kakisheway (Loud Voice) signed Treaty 4 on September 15, 1874. In 1881, Indian Agent McDonald and colonial surveyors decided to place Kakisheway and Chacachas on the same reserve without their consent. In 1884, Kakisheway's son Ochapowace became chief of the amalgamated bands. FAQ: How are "indispensable adaptations" of the Catechism accomplished? The content of the Catechism is communicated in a straightforward way to assist authors, editors and publishers of national and local catechetical materials under the guidance of the Bishop. The big bang, which is today posited as the origin of the world, does not contradict the divine act of creation; rather, it requires it ... Evolution of nature is not inconsistent with the notion of creation because evolution presupposes the creation of beings which evolve."
