

A Word About Trauma...

Trauma and associated words are being used more now than ever. Do we know the origins of these words? Are their meanings different now than when they were first used? Each week we will explore a trauma-associated word's origins, meanings and evolution.

Dissociate (dɪˈsəʊʃɪˌeɪt, -sɪ-) dis·so·ci·ate is a noun In the mid-16th century, it is from the Latin n dissociat- 'separated,' from the verb dissociate, from dis- (expressing reversal) + sociare 'join together' (from socius 'companion'). Attested from the 1540s as a past-participle adjective meaning "separated." Dissociated in psychology (1890) was "characterized by mental disjunction," hence dissociated personality (1905) is a "pathological state in which two or more distinct personalities exist in the same person." Dissociation is one way the mind copes with too much stress, such as during a traumatic event.

Ochapowace First Nation is a Plains Cree band located on the North side of Round Lake and the Qu'Appelle River and has a population of approximately 1500 band members who live on and off reserve. Kakisheway (Loud Voice) signed Treaty 4 on September 15, 1874. In 1881, Indian Agent McDonald and colonial surveyors decided to place Kakisheway and Chacachas on the same reserve without their consent. In 1884, Kakisheway's son Ochapowace became chief of the amalgamated bands. 


