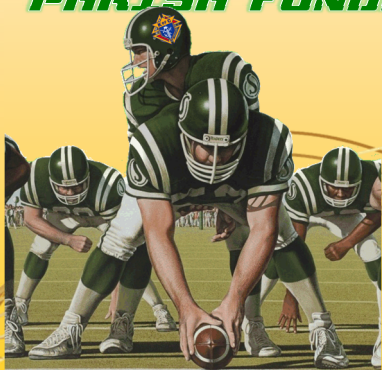

IMPORTANT: March for Life update

We are making big last-minute changes to the Saskatchewan March for Life this year. We ask that you carefully read the following, so that we can still share our Pro Life voice.

The original plan was for a collective (social distanced) Silent Witness in one location in Regina. Due to the increasing pressure from the government, unchanging restrictions and the risk of our supporters being fined, we have made an alternate plan for the silent witness.

If we can't gather in one location, we can gather as one across the province! We have decided to gather in groups of 10 outside the offices of our Members of the Legislative Assembly (MLAs).

Below is a google document link. There you can find MLAs' regions, office locations and the amount of empty spots available, so that there are no more than 10 people at each location. You can choose to witness in your region or another. Please email francis@saskprolife.com to save yourself and others a spot! You will receive a confirmation email if your spot has been successfully reserved.

May is Reverence For Life month



In 2013, Archbishop Daniel Bohan established the Archdiocesan Commission for Reverence for Life. The Commission, which works in close cooperation with the Archdiocesan Social Justice Office, has as its mandate "the promotion of reverence for human life in all its stages within the Archdiocese of Regina". The Reverence for Life Commission's goal is to assist the parishes of the Archdiocese of Regina to better advocate for and promote the dignity of the human person, especially where that dignity is seriously threatened. October has been established as 'Reverence for Life month', a month especially dedicated to the celebrations of the value and dignity of human life in the Archdiocese of Regina.

During May let us all reaffirm the value of human life, its sacredness and renew the call for us all to respect, protect, heal, love, and serve every human life. During the month of May, here are some of the activities that we will be observing during Respect for Life month.

- Throughout May, a Reverence For Life prayer is said before all the Masses.
- We are displaying a Reverence for Life banner in the church.
- This weekend we will be playing a video from Archbishop Don and the Reverence For Life committee before the weekend Masses. The video can also be seen on the main page of our website.
- May 7th is the First Friday Adoration for Life and Rosary. It will be broadcast by the Archdiocese of Regina via their YouTube channel. Watch for the link on the main page of our web-site.
- On May 19th, at 7:00pm there is a webinar with guest speakers from Birthright Regina, reaching out to mothers with unplanned pregnancies, The Sisters of Life on healing from abortion, Mary Heilman on Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide and Scott Hayward from RIGHT NOW.
