

## SHARING OUR FAITH IN REGINA AND AREA

February 10, 2019 Reflection - 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isaiah 6: 1-2a, 3-8 • 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 • Luke 5:1-11 "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." -Luke 5:8

We are blessed by the Lord all the time. How do we show God that we are grateful for the blessings he showers on us? One way is to begin by saying thank you for our blessings and remembering God has given them to us - we haven't earned them on our own. Today's Gospel shows us that if we listen to God and his commands, he will surprise us with blessings, just like Simon Peter was surprised by the HUGE catch of fish.
