

Resurrection Parish Financial Update Mass Collections & Donations January to March, 2019

Since the March 2nd & 3rd Mass Presentations which introduced the Toonie Campaign, and the ongoing bulletin updates promoting the Campaign, the following has occurred.

- One-time donations are 32% higher than 2019 Budget and 2018 Actual.
- 10% of Pre-authorized donors have increased their contributions, either through a one-time donation or incremental increases to either their weekly or monthly contributions.
- Overall Mass Collections and Donations are approximately \$2,100 higher each Sunday in March, 2019 versus March, 2018.



- Mass Collections are \$18,000 behind budget. This is partially offset by a positive trend for one-time donations. The 2019 net budget shortfall for the January to March period is approximately \$12,700.
