


**Children's Liturgy at Resurrection Parish

1. Aug Year to Date Financial Results – Operations




2. Highlights of Financial

- The surplus Aug 2024 Year to date is \$48,580 compared to Aug 2023 Year to date loss of \$(989).
- Our surplus is mainly due to some major Hall & Catering functions, an increase in Mass collections as well as managing expenses.
- More repairs/upgrades were done in 2023 (lights, waxing floors and painting lines in parking) than in 2024 to date. We are in the process of scheduling the next steps of repairs/upgrades for our Parish.


