## Did you know...

- Revenues in 2018 are about \$2,920 per day.
- 74% of revenues are provided by Mass Collections (Envelope, Loose Collections and Pre-authorized Giving). The following chart illustrates the revenue category breakdowns.



## Did you know...

- It costs about \$3,100 per day to operate our Parish. Year-to-date expenditures are approximately \$14k less than 2017.
- The following chart illustrates the expenditure breakdowns by function.



#### Did you know...

- The Parish has approximately 2,180 registered families.
- Of these 2,180 families, approximately 1,100 provide contributions on a regular basis.
- Of these 1,100 donors, approximately 300 contribute through Preauthorized Giving. This form of giving promotes consistent giving for the Parish and allows donors a convenient option for giving even when they are away. Also, for your convenience, "E-transfers" are now another giving option.
- If you are a registered donor with the Parish, through Envelopes or Pre-authorized Giving, you will receive a registered tax receipt for income tax purposes.
- The following graph illustrates the average weekly contributions provided by 1,054 donors from January 1 to October 31, 2018.



## Please take the time to consider... If all of us, that are part of these 1,054 donors, provided an <u>extra</u> onetime donation of \$50, in 2018, this year's deficit of \$55,000 could be virtually eliminated.

#### Did you know...

 The mortgage for Phase II and the Rectory is currently \$1.9 million. The mortgage is with the Archdiocese at 4% interest (fixed rate). Monthly payments are \$12,000, with approximately 65% being principal repayment.
